## STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL</b> (funeral director's charges only)	<b>£1998</b>
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£720
<b>Collecting</b> and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£200 in hours
<b>Care of the deceased</b> person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's [Formby premises] only	£250
Providing a suitable <b>coffin</b> – this will be made from [a simple oak effect veneered coffin with Nickel plated furnishings]	£449
<b>Viewing</b> of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer) excluding embalming	£67
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a <b>hearse</b> or other appropriate vehicle	£312

<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
<b>Burial</b> (funeral director's charges only)	£1040 (inc bearers)
<b>Cremation</b> (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) <sup>2</sup>	£800

<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended <b>burial</b> funeral, the burial fee <sup>1</sup> In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	£900-1040
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an <b>Attended cremation funeral</b> , the cremation fee. <sup>2</sup> In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	£620-895

<b>ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES</b>	
This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them.	
Examples include:	
Additional mileage (price per mile)	£1.10
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer)	£0-160
Collection and delivery of ashes	POA
Embalming (£100+£67 visiting)	£167
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.)	£199-£250
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	POA

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

1 This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.  
2 In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

### INVOICE TERMS

Invoice	Payable within 60 days of invoice date.
Interest	Interest payable at 14% per annum after 60 days of invoice date. Interest is calculated and chargeable monthly
Deposits	We do not require deposits prior to the funeral taking place once the contractual agreement is signed detailing all of the funeral arrangements
Solicitors and probate	We should be advised of any solicitor acting as executor of the estate or of any probate proceedings
Payment types	We accept payments by bank transfer, debit card, credit card, cheque and cash
Non-payment	In the event of non payment we reserve the right to employ a third party to obtain the balance, whereby they may add additional fees and charges and interest
